REPORTS

Administration discussed water meters for Commercial customers as Council has advised that all Commercial customers must have water meters installed as of October 31st. Council suggest that the customer purchase the water meters and have them installed at their cost. Council agreed that the customer has the option if they choose to amortize the cost of the meter over 24 months.

Administration informed Council that YTG has advised that non-refundable recyclables will no longer be collected and hauled. YTG will assist with the purchase of a compactor to help offset the cost. Tenders have been drafted and advertised for the landfill fencing and concrete slab and will close on July 30th.

Administration discussed the solid waste permit and concerns from YTG regarding potential contamination liability. Council suggested that Administration research the information from the lawyer which the Town retained for environmental legal services on this matter.

BY-LAWS

By-Law 15-05, being a bylaw to govern the use of parks and public open space within the Town of Watson Lake be introduced for First & Second Reading.

Councilor Slager expressed concerns with the bylaw disallowing tents at the Watson Lake Airport. The bylaw states that only self-contained camping units will be allowed. There was much debate on this matter. Members of Council discussed various problems that have resulted this year by allowing persons to camp at the airport. After much debate, Council agreed that tents shall not be permitted at the Airport.

Council agreed that the bylaw be amended that applicants must wait three days as opposed to seven days to reapply for a camping permit at the WL Airport.
