DELEGATION

Mr. Mandeep Sidhu and Mr. Ian Robertson presented Council with a proposal for a lot enlargement to accommodate a comprehensive refurbishment of the present Campground Services and related commercial services, in order to modernize and meet RV park standards and the demands of tourists. The enlargement would require the acquisition of 3.9 hectares of crown land adjacent to their existing property. A letter is required to accompany their application indicating that Council is prepared to consider a land use amendment that would involve a change to the OCP and Zoning Bylaw. Council agreed to discuss this further and have an answer for the November 1st meeting.

REPORTS

Administration provided Council with an update on various matters:

- Preparation for the fourth round of union negotiations anticipated for the week of November $7^{th} 10^{th}$.
- Substantial completion has been signed off on the Recycling Depot Compactor Building.
- The critical exterior work has been completed at the swimming pool and now the interior work can commence.

- The new garbage truck is expected to arrive in early November and training will take place with staff on the new vehicle.
- The YG water valve replacement upgrade is complete. The Boil water advisory has been lifted and notices have been forwarded in the mail to residents.

Council inquired about the hours that Town staff assisted Norcope on the valve replacement project and suggested the hours be calculated and billed to the project.

Council addressed the outdoor lighting at the Water treatment facility and concerns that have been expressed by residents that the lights are shining directly into their homes. Council suggest this matter be resolved.

CHAMBER OF COMMERCE CANADA 150 CELEBRATION

Councilor Irvin provided Council with a brief update on special events and activities which the Watson Lake Chamber of Commerce is considering for the Canada 150 celebrations.

Council addressed a development permit application submitted by Diocese Yukon for an addition to the existing thrift store. The application had been declined as the building constitutes a non-conforming use as defined in the Zoning Bylaw.

The application was appealed to Council for consideration. Council discussed the application and the regulations for what is permitted in an Institutional Zone. After much consideration Council agreed to approve the development permit as a conditional use.
