Council suggested that more discussion is necessary to be held with the Circus event coordinator to request the additional costs to cover the expenses.

Mr. Eric Little provided Council with information regarding a solar project that is being proposed for Watson Lake by Dynamic Microgrids. The project which has been supported by ATCO Electric will provide renewable power and storage facilities to reduce the cost of electricity. Dynamic is requesting access to lease a 6 acre parcel of Town owned property for this project. Council discussed the site that is being proposed as it is currently being held in reserve for Town requirements. Council agreed that the property can be utilized by both parties, and the rental of the property will generate revenue to the Town.

Council is open to discussion on a lease and Mr. Little agreed to liaise with the CAO and provide more information prior to a decision.
