LETTER FROM MINISTER MOSTYN

CAO Cam Lockwood met with Minister Mostyn and spoke about the steaming of the culverts along the Alaska Highway being very expensive for the Town of Watson Lake. Also, discussion took place regarding the mowing of the boulevards done by the Town of Watson Lake Public Works department. It is very expensive and the compensation received from the Yukon Government is not adequate for the costs incurred.

LETTER FROM PREMIER SANDY SILVER

Discussion took place regarding the Carbon Rebate which the Town of Watson is eligible to receive. At the AYC Annual General Meeting, there was a Motion to push the Government of Yukon for details on when the revenue will be forthcoming from the Federal government.
